### IF APPLYING FOR: Ruel Wright Memorial Scholarship - criteria:

### Eligible applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be between the ages of 18 and 40.
- 2. Applicant must be proficient at the apprentice skill level and working toward Journeyman. This award to be used to learn and hone the advanced level skills needed in order to become an established and profitable craftsman.
- 3. Applicant must have, or have regular access to appropriate shop space and tools. This requirement may also be met by consistently working with another established smith.
- 4. Applicant should have as their goal a career where blacksmithing provides their primary source of income.

### IF APPLYING FOR: Maritime Knife Supply-ABS Intro Scholarship - criteria:

### Eligible applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Open to students 16-30 years of age.
- 2. Open to beginners with less than 2 years experience.

## How to apply for scholarship:

- 1. Complete the Scholarship Application form, <u>incomplete</u> forms will not be accepted.
- 2. Write a 1-2 page personal narrative statement (using the questions of the application) describing your reasons for applying to the program. Please include the following information.
- 3. Complete the list of course choices (first and second) that you are applying for.
- 4. Enclose a check (or other form of payment) of \$35.00 (non-refundable) application fee payable to the New England School of Metalwork.

## Important Dates- Please read!

Scholarship applications must be received by **December 1, 2022**. Applications will be reviewed and selection will be complete with winners notified by **January 1, 2023**.

The New England School of Metalwork, Metalsmithing Program; awards four scholarships annually, which are available through competitive application to those who are 16 years of age or older. Two are awarded in Bladesmithing and two in Blacksmithing. Applicants may only apply for one scholarship annually. Applicants are encouraged to be selective in their choice (when applicable) of workshop, indicating first and second choices. The scholarships are for one course and the associated cost such as registration and material fees. A dorm or travel allowance of 35% of course cost is a part of each scholarship. Please keep in mind that answers to the questions on the application form are an important part of the review process. Focused application responses and thoughtful discussion of ones plans and focus of the scholarship tend to be more favorably received.
